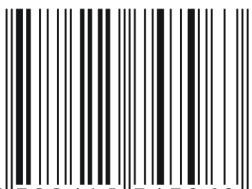

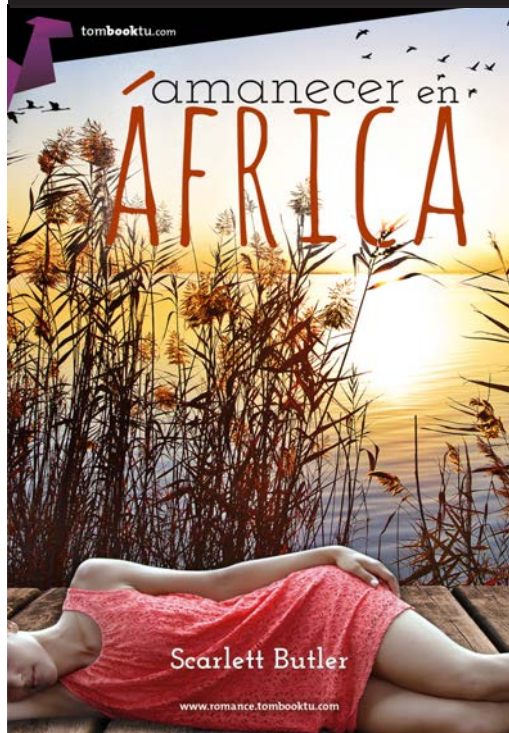

Elliot Savannah is a mysterious doctor who attends the Obande mission to help the young doctor.

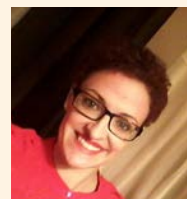
There he will find what he has been running from: feeling again.
